We are pleased to inform 814 Sand Inc. (SI) that its application to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program has been approved. In accordance with 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 26, SI is now certified as a DBE with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and the Texas Unified Certification Program (TUCP). SI can now bid statewide as a DBE on federally assisted contracts in the following work categories:

Major Structures, Underground and Utility Work, Landscaping, Earthwork, Base and Subbase, Hauling

SI must perform a Commercially Useful Function (CUF) to satisfy DBE contract goals on federally-funded transportation-related projects. SI performs a CUF when it is responsible for the execution of the work of the contracts and is carrying out its responsibilities by actually performing, managing and supervising the work involved. SI is also responsible for negotiating price, determining quality and quantity, ordering, paying for, and installing (where applicable) the materials and supplies needed to accomplish the contract. TxDOT, and any of the TUCP certifying agencies, reserve the right to review SI's certification at any time it is determined that such a review is warranted.

SI is required to submit a no-change affidavit form and supporting documents on the anniversary of its DBE certification. TxDOT will notify SI at the email address listed in the TUCP directory at www.txdot.txdotcms.com. As such, it is SI's responsibility to notify this office of any changes in ownership, management and control, or contact information. Failure to comply with these requirements will indicate SI's failure to cooperate under 49 CFR §26.109(c) and TxDOT will initiate decertification efforts.
